Would you like to plan and create your own traditional Japanese Garden? Then this full day workshop at Ness is a must for you. We are fortunate to have the world famous Professor Masao Fukuhara who will talk about how different styles of Japanese gardens are designed during the morning session and then do a 'hands-on' practical demonstration in the afternoon.



Professor Masao Fukuhara is Associate Professor at Osaka University of Arts. He has worked on the design, planning and overseeing the construction of Japanese gardens as well as being involved in researching, surveying and restoring existing Japanese gardens constructed in different parts of the world.

Through building different styles of Japanese gardens and carrying out various restoration works abroad he has contributed greatly to the understanding of the styles and techniques of Japanese gardens.

In 2001 he designed the Gold Winning and Best in Show garden at the RHS Chelsea Flower Show. This garden was later transferred and reconstructed at the National Botanic Garden of Wales under the Professor's supervision.
