Examples by the National Association of Flower Arranging Society of the Western style of Japanese flower arranging.

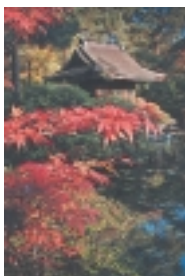
